



APPLICATION OF REFUND FROM TRAVEL UNDERTAKING'S SECURITY FOR PACKAGE OR LINKED TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS

Before submitting the application please be kind to read the following information!

- The application of refund from travel undertaking's security for package or linked travel arrangements along with all the annexes needs to be presented to the Consumer Protection and Technical Regulatory Authority (CPTRA) within the term. Information about the term set can be found on CPTRA's web page.

Payments out of the security can be made:

- if a travel undertaking is unable to perform an obligation arising from a package travel contract due to their solvency
(Characteristics of a package- at least two different types of travel services for the purpose of the same trip, the travel services are combined by one tour operator before a single contract on all services is concluded);
- due to travel undertaking's solvency a travel service constituting part of linked travel arrangements is not performed
(Characteristics of linked travel arrangements- at least two different types of travel services for the purpose of the same trip, the traveller concludes separate contracts with the individual travel service providers, one travel undertaking facilitates concluding the contracts).

In order to be reimbursed for whole package and / or the remaining part of a package, copies of the following documents must be attached to the application:

1. proof of payment for the package;
2. package travel contract;
3. proof that the package or part of a package has been or will be canceled;
- if necessary/desired, other relevant documents.

The application for reimbursement for an unused package gift voucher must be accompanied by copies of:

1. a document certifying payment for an unused package gift voucher;
- if necessary/desired, other relevant documents.

The application for reimbursement of payments made to the facilitator for linked travel arrangements must be accompanied by copies of:

- proof of payment for linked travel arrangements to the facilitator;
- contracts for linked travel arrangements;
- proof that the travel service or part thereof which is included in linked travel arrangements has not been provided or will not be provided;
- if necessary/desired, other relevant documents
