

**Agreement between the Finnish Transport and Communications  
Agency and the Consumer Protection and Technical Regulatory  
Authority of Estonia concerning the use of the 24.250 - 27.500  
GHz frequency band in border areas**

## **1. Principles and definitions**

- 1.1. The 24.250 - 27.500 GHz frequency band, as referred to in this Agreement is harmonized for terrestrial systems capable of providing wireless broadband electronic communications services, in accordance with European Commission Implementing Decision (EU) 2019/784 and for Mobile/Fixed Communications Networks (MFCN) in accordance with CEPT ECC Decision (18)06.

## **2. Use of frequencies without co-ordination**

- 2.1. Estonia and Finland may use the 24.250 - 27.500 GHz frequency band without requirement to coordinate transmitters with each other.

## **3. General**

- 3.1. In the presence of interference, a report of harmful interference shall be presented in accordance with Appendix 10 of the Radio Regulations. The other Administration shall take all possible steps in order to eliminate the interference.

## **4. Revision and cancellation**

- 4.1. This Agreement may be revised upon mutual agreement of the two administrations.
  - 4.2. This Agreement may be cancelled with a notice of at least twelve months from any of the two parties.

## 5. Entry into force

- 5.1. This Agreement shall enter into force from 1<sup>st</sup> of July 2020.
- 5.2. This Agreement has been drawn up in two identical copies, one for Estonia and one for Finland.
